TRUCK AND TRAILER PARKING PROHIBITION  
AND REGULATION BYLAW

BYLAW TITLE

A Bylaw to prohibit and regulate the parking of motor vehicles and trailers within the Town of Hepburn

WHEREAS Section 12(1) of the Municipalities Act, provides that a Municipality has the direction, control and management of all streets within the Municipality; and Section 8 of the Municipalities Act gives Municipalities the general power to pass bylaws for the purposes of the municipality that it considers expedient;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to prohibit and regulate the parking of motor vehicles and trailers within the Town of Hepburn and provide for the removal, detention or impounding of vehicles unlawfully occupying a portion of highway or public place;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Hepburn, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall park any of the following vehicles or trailers on any highway:

- i) a motor home of any licenced weight;
- ii) any trailer or semi-trailer of any licenced weight, or
- iii) any motor vehicle having a licenced gross vehicle weight exceeding 5,000 kilograms;
- iv) any trailer detached from its towing vehicle of any licenced or unlicenced weight.

2. Any vehicle unlawfully occupying any portion of municipal property, highway or public place may upon the order of a peace officer or Bylaw Enforcement Officer, be removed to an impoundment in such a place as directed by the peace officer or Bylaw Enforcement Officer and such a vehicle will not be released to its owner until the cost of its removal and impoundment is paid.

3. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of section 1 of this Bylaw or fails to comply therewith or with any of this Bylaw or fails to comply therewith or with any notice or order given there-under shall be guilty of an offence and upon summary conviction, shall be liable to a fine of \$50 and a continuing fine of \$20 per day.

3. This Bylaw shall come into effect on third reading thereof.
