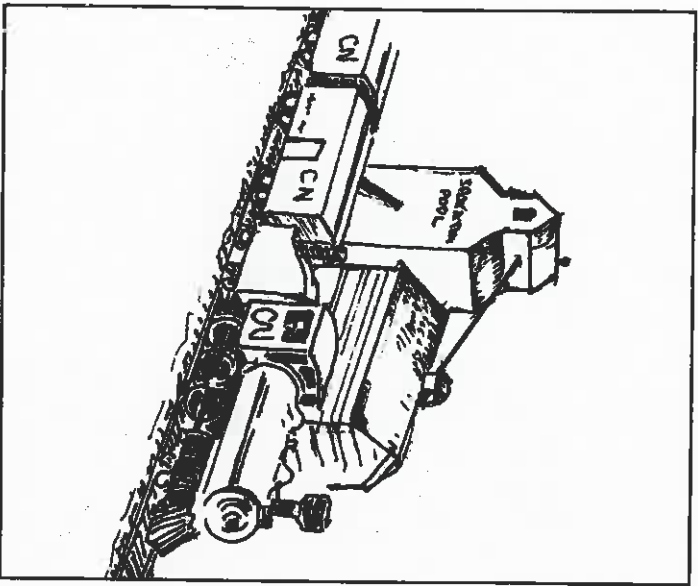

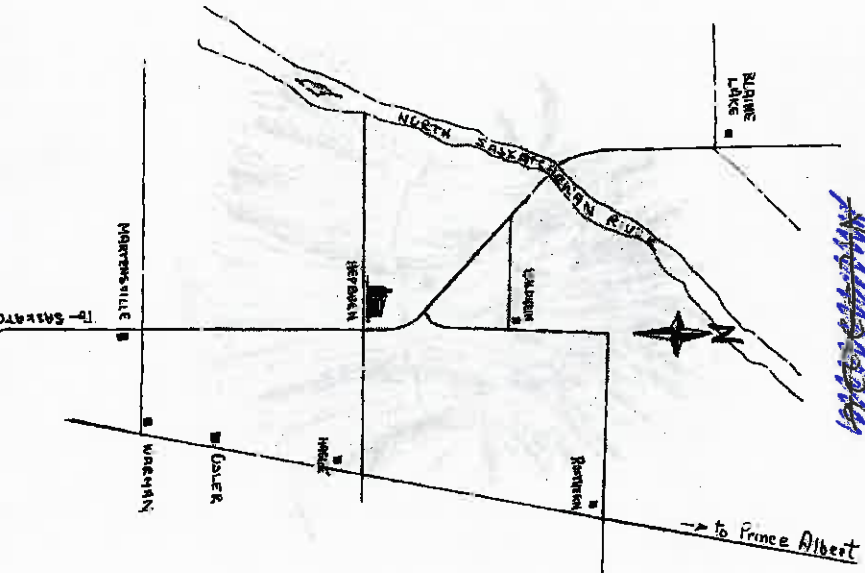

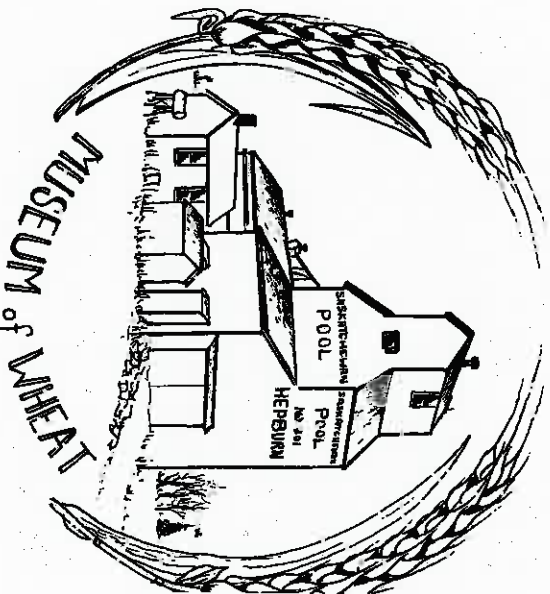

# STATEMENT of PURPOSE

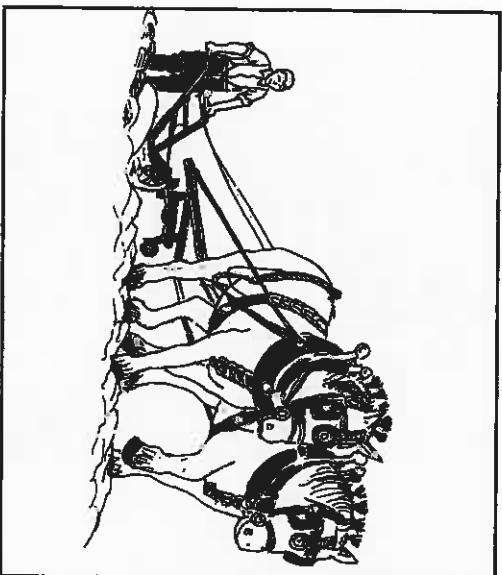

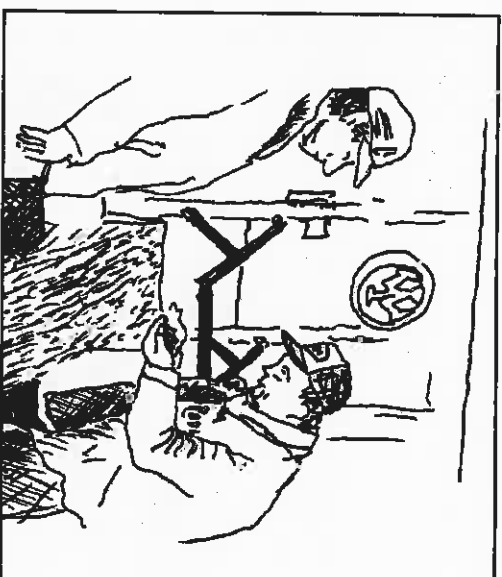
