## Municipal Updates

### Discounts on Property Taxes

In economic response to COVID-19, Town Council has extended the 4% discount on the municipal portion of property taxes until December 31, 2020.

### Interest Charges on Utilities

In response to COVID-19, Council waived interest charges on UTILITIES for April 1, May 1, & June 1. In addition, Council elected to waive interest on Utilities on July 1.

### Bleachers

The Town of Hepburn purchased two 15' long portable bleachers to be used for town functions and at the ball diamonds.



### Paving

Paving is planned to proceed for **Poplar Place, Crocus Court, Willow Place, Albert Place, and Heritage Place** this summer. Affected residents will receive communication about the project by letter.
