How You Can Prevent a Sewer Line Backup

• **Do not** pour grease or cooking oil down the drain. Instead, scrape out or pour cooking oil and grease into a container or plastic bag and dispose of it in your kitchen garbage.



• **Do not** dispose of large absorbent items like paper towels, diapers,

baby wipes, or feminine products down the toilet; these are not items that disintegrate like toilet paper will including "flushable" wipes. These products should be disposed of in your garbage.

Kitchen garburators increase the amount of • organic material in the service lines. Organic material can stick to the lines and over time cause blockages. Compost your organic material instead.

To help prevent a sewer backup, be mindful of what goes down the drain. Your pipes are not built to handle most food items and will almost always cause a blockage in the short or long term. When in doubt, properly dispose of these items by throwing them away.
