HERITAGE HAPPENINGS (Hepburn & Area):

On Sunday, September 27, the 100th year anniversary of **Parker School** was marked. The school was located between Hepburn and Waldheim, at Township Road 414. Update from Don Rice: "We had just about 30 people show up including a lot of former students. Bertha Thiessen, who was both a former student and the longest-serving teacher at the school was there, and very excited to see her old students, some of which she hadn't seen in many years. She shared some precious memories of her days at the school and I led a short ceremony to commemorate the 100th Anniversary of the first day of when my Grandmother Annie (Strauss) Wiebe taught the very first class at Parker School. We found out that my Grandmother had actually taught Bertha's mother (Katie Friesen) and 2 of Katie's sisters -- Susie & Sarah Friesen! (Friesen) Peters). I am looking into costs and feasibility of fixing the school up. I will have a building inspector advising of costs and will update people once that info is available."
