Council Highlights

A grant application for Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program – COVID-19 resilience was submitted for \$150,000 for a park project to upgrade the existing Little Park (404 2nd Street East) and construct a Northwest municipal park to enhance and protect the public health of Town of Hepburn residents during the COVID-19 pandemic. We should know the status of the grant by the end of 2020. **If we receive the grant, the project would commence in the spring of 2021.**

HMC Management will be providing a council orientation for the newly elected Mayor and Council in January 2021.

Council set a minimum of \$150 per transaction to load bulk water cards effective January 1, 2021.

The regular meetings of Council have been changed to the **3rd Tuesday of every month** until further notice due to COVID19. Council meetings will be held at 422 Main Street (Hepburn Centre) to allow for sufficient physical distancing.

A new chlorine testing device has been approved for purchase to improve the town's water testing capabilities.
