SaskEnergy's Tune-Up Assistance Program (TAP).

Given the current circumstances and the challenges the people of our communities are facing, SaskEnergy wants to reach and help as many people as possible with the TAP program. Until October 1, 2021 **income qualified homeowners** can apply for TAP. TAP is a program designed to help eligible homeowners with furnace maintenance and repairs by providing a free furnace inspection ("Home Heating Tune-Up"), 2 free furnace filters, a free carbon monoxide alarm and \$100 in repairs if required. It's a value of up to \$300, and really does provide members of our community with safety, education, and some peace of mind in the winter months. Property Taxes

Did you know that you can pay your taxes with online

banking? Go to your online banking account and add the Town of Hepburn as a payee. To enter an account number, use the letter 'T' for Taxes, followed by a 0 and your **3 digit tax roll number**. Example: T0(Tax Roll Number). NOTE: Different banks may require more or less zeros.
