Municipal Updates

With warmer weather upon us, Council is happy to announce significant happenings related to projects around town. The parks & pathways project is nearing completion with a playground installation in Whisper Ridge and the community park improvement scheduled next! A section of the roof at Heritage Common is being replaced, and many events and bookings are underway there. Town staff have completed an audit of the town's sidewalks, with pedestrian safety in mind.

The town is bustling with summer activity! With this in mind, I encourage all of us to consider good road etiquette – reminding children of bike safety & drivers to be mindful of pedestrians and cyclists. If you are out walking or riding, ensure attention and right of way is given to vehicle traffic.

This is a friendly reminder that home owners are responsible for mowing the grass in the ditches around their homes. Together we can keep our town looking clean and beautiful all summer long!



Potential Causes of High Water Bills

An unusually high water bill is most often caused by a leak or change in water use. Some common causes include: a leaking toilet, a toilet that continues to run after being flushed, a dripping faucet (a faucet drip can waste 20 gallons of water a day or more), filling or topping up a swimming pool, watering the yard (check for an open

hose bib), kids home for summer or school holidays, guests, water-cooled air conditioners, a broken water pipe or obvious leak (check the pipes in the basement or crawlspace), the water heater could be leaking, or water softener cycling continuously.
