Sewer Problems?

If you experience a

sewer blockage please call the town office or the emergency on call phone before taking any action. Section 31 of the Utility Management Bylaw states: The Town expects that the owner will immediately contact Town Administration or Public Works staff prior to any work being undertaken. If no contact is made with the Town prior to the contractor commencing work, the Town will not take on the responsibility for any of the billing relative to repair work that is done. Any contractor hired to do work in the Town will need to be vetted by the Town prior to commencing work or the Town will not take responsibility for any of the billing

Bylaw Compliance

Grass: Please ensure that your grass is maintained in accordance with Sections 8 to 11 of Bylaw No. 11-2013, the Nuisance Abatement Bylaw and does not exceed 0.20 metres in height.

Pet owners: Please ensure that you clean up after your pets and dispose of their feces properly. Please be respectful of town and private property. Pets running at large is not permitted. They must be properly contained on your property or on a leash at all times. Failure to comply will result in a fine according to our Animal Control Bylaw No. 43-2017.

Fire Safety

With the weather warming up and residents wanting to enjoy backyard fires and BBQ's, please remember to ensure all burning is in compliance with our Fire Prevention Bylaw No. 55-2018. As per section 18 of the Bylaw, All Open-air fires shall be contained in a non-combustible receptacle constructed of cement, brick, or sheet metal with a minimum 18-gauge thickness. The receptacle shall be covered with a heavy gauge screen with openings not exceeding 13 millimetres and the size of the fire box of any receptacle shall not exceed 1.2 metres.
