### **Property Taxes**

Did you know that you can pay your taxes with online banking?
Go to your online banking account and add the Town of Hepburn as a payee. To enter an account number, use the letter 'T' for Taxes, followed by a 0 and your 3-



digit tax roll number. Example: T0(Tax Roll Number). NOTE: Different banks may require more or less zeros.
