Council Roles

Councillor **Erica Baerwald** was appointed as Acting Mayor, with Councillor **Joseph Homontowski** being appointed as Deputy Mayor for a three-month term. Councillors will all have a three-month term as Deputy Mayo.

Mayor By-Election

Council determined that the by-election date for the Vacant Mayor position be set for **Wednesday**, **January 22**, **2025**, with Nomination Day being **Wednesday**, **December 18**, **2024**. Call for Nominations will be advertised in early December.
