#### **Snow Clearing**

#### Childcare in HEPBURN!

Hepburn is set to receive funding from the Governments of Canada & Saskatchewan for the creation of a 30-space licensed childcare centre for infants, toddlers and preschool child care spaces! The funding is for capital and start-up costs. The daycare will be run by a separate non-profit organization with a volunteer board. Access to licensed childcare will provide residents in Hepburn and Area with the opportunity to utilize the new federal and provincial grants which will reduce their childcare costs. This is the start of realizing the vision to be able to provide broad early childhood education services in Hepburn. This is very exciting news! More information to come!
